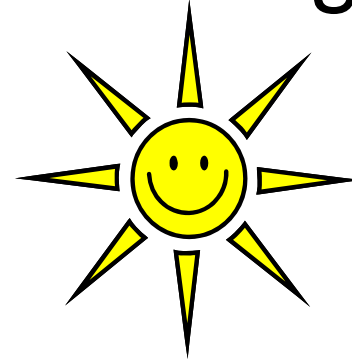

The total cost for one week of Camp is \$120. Room, board, crafts, all breaks, and a T-shirt are included. A minimum registration fee of \$20 is required and is non-refundable. The balance of \$100 is due one week prior to the first day of Camp. Late payment, from one-week prior through the first day of Camp will be \$110.

- Camp Smiling Acres is operated by a Board of Trustees, all of whom are members of the Church of Christ.
- The Camp is located on 118 acres of beautiful, piney woods and rolling hills near Greensburg, Louisiana. This location is within an hour's drive of Baton Rouge and is easily accessible via Interstate 55 and Louisiana Highway 10.
- A full-time director conducts each Camp session. Each cabin is under the direct supervision of a Christian counselor, who seeks to be a personal friend to each camper in his or her cabin.
- The kitchen staff is at work preparing delicious and nutritious meals long before the campers awake each day.
- During the day, Bible teachers, athletic directors, lifeguards, and craft instructors plan and provide meaningful and fun activities.
- All possible preparations are being made for every camper to have a safe, healthy, and fun-filled week at Camp. Great food, healthy exercise, and plenty of rest are standard policy for every session.
- Other activities include devotionals, Bible study, talent shows, singing, hiking, games, softball, volleyball, ping-pong, swimming, basketball, badminton, and lots of fun with good friends.
- What to bring:

- Each camper must pack separately. Be sure to mark your belongings. Do not bring valuables to Camp.
- You may want to make sure that your tetanus or booster shot is current prior to Camp. Check with your personal physician.
- Emergency communication with Camp may be secured by calling 225-927-6954, 225-766-0784, or 225-769-4918. Someone at these numbers will contact Camp for you.
- Daily activities at Camp are highly structured and scheduled. Visitors can disrupt the daily schedule and interrupt the routine and continuity of Camp. **Visitors are not allowed for campers or staff.**

- **CHECK-IN TIME:** Sunday afternoon between 4:00 and 6:00 p.m. Please do not arrive before 4:00 p.m. Camp officially begins at 6:00 p.m. All parents and other visitors must be clear of Camp by that time.
- **CHECK-OUT TIME:** The following Saturday morning at 9:00 a.m. Please be prompt. All facilities and cabins must be cleaned and prepared for the next session.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From the town of Greensburg, drive west on Louisiana Highway 10 for about one mile. Turn right at the old gas & grocery store. Follow this blacktop road about two miles and turn left on the gravel road. Follow this gravel road about one mile and turn left into Camp Smiling Acres.

RULES FOR CAMPERS

Camp management and each session director reserve the right to send any camper home when the terms of this brochure or any other rules are not followed. All campers must comply with the following:

1. Campers must obey these rules and any others that any session director may deem necessary.
2. Campers may not leave the Camp grounds.
3. Campers must attend all Bible classes, devotionals, and all other organized activities.
4. Campers must turn in their car keys to the session director.
5. The boys' cabin and bathhouse area is off-limits to all girls and the girls' cabin and bathhouse area is off-limits to all boys.
6. Campers must dress modestly. Each session director has the authority and will determine what is appropriate and modest dress for both girls and boys.
7. Use of tobacco, liquor, or any drugs (except appropriate medication) in any form will not be allowed.
8. All medications, both prescription and non-prescription, must be turned in to the session director and/or his designee with written instructions for use.
9. Campers may not leave their cabins after lights-out.
10. Do not bring any money or other valuables to Camp. Camp will not be responsible for any personal items that become lost or damaged.
11. Radios, tape players, CD players, electronic games, cell phones and any other such items are not allowed. Please do not bring them to Camp.
